Our History

In 2000, a small group of Somerset County citizens saw a need to care for, manage, and treat ownerless domestic animals. They established The Humane Society of Somerset County, a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. The Society's mission is to prevent cruelty to animals, promote respect for their intrinsic value, eliminate pet overpopulation and enhance the bond between humans and animals.

Every year the Society receives hundreds of calls for help. We provide help both directly and with other rescue groups. We facilitate pet adoptions to families, and coordinate the rescue and rehabilitation of dozens of abused animals every year.

We strive to find loving homes and provide fulfilling lives for all of the animals in Somerset County.



Foster/Adoption Program

Since the beginning the Society has used foster care, placing animals into temporary homes until we can find permanent homes for them.

The Society provides vet care, including spay or neuter surgeries, for all animals in the foster care system. Then we find forever homes for them using our web site, other web sites, appearances at public places, and newspaper advertising.

Rescue Program

We respond daily to phone calls and emails ranging from lost pets to suspected animal cruelty.

We work with local law enforcement agencies to document and intercede in cases of animal mistreatment. We supervise the care and rehabilitation of abused animals.

Outreach and Education

Our goal is to increase awareness about issues facing companion and feral animals in our community. We work with the media to inform the public about current issues. We participate in community events, offer brochures and presentations to organizations and schools, and testify before government agencies in support of humane legislation.

Population Control

The Society combats overpopulation with long-term control initiatives. We manage feral colonies by trapping, sterilizing, and releasing the cats where they will be safe and receive proper care.

We work with local veterinarians to conduct low-cost spay/neuter clinics for county residents.
